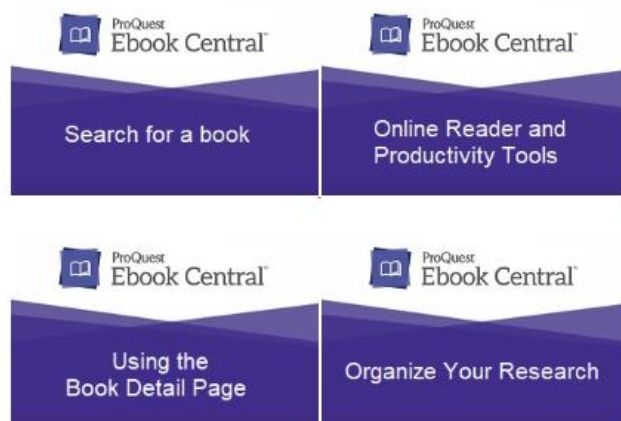


### ProQuest Ebook Central
